He/she must possess strong interpersonal, leadership, and communication skills, and have the ability to work collaboratively with colleagues. Responsibilities of the position include classroom teaching, student advising, after-school club leadership, and coaching or its equivalent.

The ideal candidate will be an educator with:

- A Bachelor's degree or above in computer science or an equivalent field
- Three years of successful classroom experience
- Experience implementing technology and project-based learning in the classroom
- A proven commitment to the development of young people as individual learners

Additional duties could include:

- Designing and teaching computer electives, including game design, app development, raspberry pi / arduino
- Working with students on independent projects
- Coaching middle and/or upper school robotics
- Teaching one or two sections of upper/middle school math as needed
- Leading participation in hack-a-thons and technology challenges
- Co-leading Code 4 Manchester
- Networking with local technology companies to design field trips and internships
- Teaching at Derryfield's X Learning Summer Camp
