Summary Faculty Description:

As a faculty member, all teachers lead as positive educators and role models for the School community of students, colleagues, parents, alumni, and trustees. A faculty member's general duties involve teaching four classes, coaching two sports or the equivalent, advising students, leading an activity, serving on a committee, providing extra help to students, attending school events, and faculty orientation (August 2015). The typical student load is 55-65 students.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities of the STEAM DIRECTOR:

- Lead strategic vision and communication of the STEAM curriculum at the School.
- Develop and teach two courses of STEAM (Level 1 and 2).
- Teach one AP and one standard Computer Science course.
- Coach the upper and middle school robotic teams, or a similar group, in STEAM competitions.

- Bachelor's Degree, prefer Masters in subject matter.
- Energetic, patient and inspiring teacher and leader.
- Five or more years of successful classroom teaching experience and experience with implementing technology and multimedia in the classroom. Demonstrable computer literacy skills.

- Clear alignment with institutional objectives, strategies and goals.
- Highly collaborative and team-oriented style.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
