Definition

•Plans, organizes, administers, and directs the operations, activities and staff of a college information technology services office including help desk services, telephone operations, instructional media services (audiovisual), and electronic repair services and oversees all technical and administrative aspects of a college's network operations.

Minimum Qualifications

Education & Experience

A Combination of education and/or experience equivalent to: Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with a degree in computer science, computer engineering, information technology, information systems, or a closely related field AND four (4) years of recent, full-time, paid experience in information systems design, information systems development, network administration, or computer applications training. Two years of the required experience must have been in a supervisory capacity. Specific experience with current technology related to the instructional process is highly desirable.

Exam Process

The examination process will include screening to ensure applications are complete and meet all minimum qualifications. The application requires the completion of Supplemental Questions to evaluate your education, training and experience relative to the required knowledge and abilities for the position. Answers should be as complete as possible, as no additional information will be accepted from applicants once the application has been submitted. The examination process will include an oral board appraisal interview (100% weight).

Only the most qualified applicants, who pass the minimum qualifications review, will be invited to the oral appraisal board interview. Passing score is 75% out of 100%.



SCCCD includes three colleges and multiple centers which serve approximately 1 million people and 18 unified and high school districts in urban and rural territories

In 1910, Fresno City College was established. It is the 1st Community College in California & the 2nd in the nation. Reedley College was first established in 1926 as Reedley Junior College and our newest college, Clovis Community College, was established in 2015. It is currently the 113th campus in California's community college system.

Our campuses offer over 100 associate of arts and science degree programs and 60 certificate of achievement programs in vocational/occupational areas as well as specialized occupational and technical training including fire, police, agriculture, forestry, automotive and aeronautics programs.

SCCCD employs over 2,300 faculty & staff, enrolls over 44,000 students & covers more than 5,743 square miles spanning several counties with an operating budget of nearly \$200 million.

Many of the cities within the 4 counties are within an hour's drive of many **mountain & lake resorts**, within 90 minutes of three national parks & located halfway between Los Angeles & San Francisco.

The City of Fresno is the **5th largest city** in the state & one of the 40 most prosperous cities in the U.S.

The seasonal events cater to a variety of interests, from the Clovis Rodeo, Christmas Tree Lane (since 1920), Civil War Reenactments, Greek Fest, Big Fresno Fair, Madera County Fair, and World Ag Expo to Car Shows, Sports Events and Marathons, the Central Valley has it all.

The **mean travel time** to work in Fresno County is 22.1 mins, Kings County is 21.1 mins, Madera County is 25.5 mins, and Tulare County is 22.7.*

The median monthly home owner costs (with a mortgage) in Fresno County is \$1,516, Kings County is \$1,423, Madera County is \$1,450 and Tulare is \$1,353.*
