- Assist teachers with the integration of technology in their classrooms.
- Provide A/V support for weekly Assemblies
- Participate in technology related professional development opportunities.
- Assess and report on all aspects of technology related to educational goals of the junior school.
- Serve as a mentor to junior school teachers and staff for technology use.
- Attend grade level and department meetings to assess and plan curriculum.
- Work with Information Technology to provide oversight of student and teacher iPads, chrome books, and laptops
- Coordinate student technology clubs and independent study in technology.
- Communicate the technology strategy to Junior School staff, students and parents.
