- Supervise assigned personnel to ensure that all responsibilities are met.
- Collaborate with the curriculum department and other departments to integrate technology TEKS/activities into curriculum and daily classroom instruction.
- Work with campus and district administrators to create plans for instructional technology professional development.
- Oversee federal and state requirements in regards to compliance with CIPA, COPA, NCLB and other cyber safety guidelines.
- Work with staff on the implementation and review of technology software, hardware and methods of instruction to integrate technology.
- Oversee the daily operations of the technology lab, technology equipment for check-out, video conferencing and equipment in district conference rooms.



- Conduct meetings as necessary for the proper functioning of the Instructional Technology & Library Media Services programs.
- Keep staff informed about current educational research, technology and materials for the improvement of instruction integrating technology.
- Assist in the recruitment and selection of Instructional Technology Specialists and Library Media Specialists.
- Communicate information regarding instructional technology.
- Organize and document online programs and educational subscriptions and renewals.
- Other duties as assigned.
