POSITION OBJECTIVE: An integral member of the Library & Technology Department's leadership team, the Director of Educational Technology advances whole-school teaching and learning with technology. In partnership with the Chief Information Officer, this person is responsible for developing and leading the strategic vision for the innovative use of educational technology at Ravenscroft in support of the school's mission. This critical school role supports the development of Ravenscroft's short-term and long term educational technology goals and partners with the leaders of the School's Library Team and Technology Team to ensure communication and collaboration exist in meeting those goals. The Director of Educational Technology also leads programs and planning of Computer Science as a discrete subject. The position leads and coaches the divisional Information Technology Specialists and Computer Science faculty in their roles and guides them through their annual Professional Growth and Development Plan for institutional, divisional, and individual goals related to the School's strategic initiatives.

QUALIFYING CHARACTERISTICS: A collaborative leader who works across stakeholders to promote teamwork, the Director of Educational Technology must possess 3 to 5 years of leadership experience, preferably in a PreK-12 environment, and should be able to effectively demonstrate designing, leading, and implementing multiple projects.

- Experience working in a blended environment (Windows, Macs, and Chromebooks) with a variety of devices and software applications
- Experience working with digital learning platforms (G-Suite for Education and Hapara's Teacher Dashboard a must; Veracross SIS a plus)
- Google Certified Educator recommended; Google Certified Trainer preferred
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Excellent emotional intelligence skills
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills
- Strong demonstrated knowledge in Educational Technology

Experience in benchmarking and performance metrics for all aspects of educational technology, for example ISTE's Lead and Transform Analysis.

- ❑ Develops, coordinates, and instructs professional development opportunities for faculty and workshops for parents on technology-related topics
