- Assist Director of Information Technology, Director of Academic Technology, Lower School Head, and faculty to evaluate, select, and implement appropriate applications and devices that are age appropriate for students.
- Collaborate and assist with Lower School publications and classroom OnCampus bulletin boards for effective student and parent communication.
- Assist in directing the school-wide technology spending, as well as the short and long range academic technology vision and plans.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Head of Lower School.
