Academic Responsibilities

- Create and execute a hands-on lab curriculum which supports and enhances the classroom science curriculum, and uses appropriate methods and tools to stimulate student understanding.
- Provide a weekly, hands-on lab experience for all LS students.
- Provide inquiry-based lab experiences, utilizing both hands-on and thinking skills that are flexible and open to the contributions of students.
- Integrate science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) through hands-on experiences based on the Engineering Design Process, creating human-made solutions to real-life problems.
- Communicate effectively with classroom teachers to coordinate STEM labs with classroom science.

- Attend all assemblies and meetings, both Lower School and across-academy events.
- Attend and be visible at lower school activities and functions
