



Lower School Robotics Teaching Position

Gilmour Academy is seeking an Instructional Technologist and Robotics Instructor for its Lower School. This position would be responsible for supporting teachers in grades PreK – 6 with their use of technology in the classroom as well as developing and implementing curriculum in the LEGO Robotics program grades 4 - 6. The position would help develop and implement professional development programming for Lower School faculty. Gilmour Academy is seeking to emphasize an atmosphere of collegial support with the LS Technologist serving as a readily accessible coaching resource for teachers' growth in instructional strategies. The position involves close coordination with the Upper School Robotics Instructor so little experience with LEGO Robotics is acceptable. Training in LEGO robotics will be made available.
