This position reports to the Chief Financial Officer.

Responsibilities:

- Model a collaborative, team approach.
- Oversee and coordinate the work of the Information Services Department in order to meet the needs of the school community.
- Manage all school technology systems, hardware and infrastructure.
- Provide leadership in developing staff and financial resources necessary to support the mission of the School.
- Work with the Assistant Principal for Teaching and Learning to implement initiatives designed to integrate technology with the academic program.
- Assist faculty, staff and students with technology-related initiatives.
- Review and evaluate technology plans, associated budgets, and related staff position to ensure campus wide consistency and efficient use of resources.
- Collaborate with the Information Services Department staff to streamline administrative tasks through the use of technology.
- Ensure compliance with industry standards in all areas of network and infrastructure operations.
- Oversee the evaluation, acquisition, implementation, and development of technology resources to support and enhance the business needs of the School.
