<u>Summary</u>: The Online Learning Coordinator will facilitate implementation and coordination of the emerging Bullis Online Program, providing quality-driven innovative online and blended online learning opportunities, including but not limited to online credit-bearing courses at the upper school grade levels. The Online Learning Coordinator will provide professional development to faculty/staff of best practices in standards-based blended and online curriculum development and online teaching.

Principal Responsibilities

- 1. Instructional Design Support
 - a. Professional Development designs, develops and delivers workshops and online training to faculty and staff in the use of instructional strategies and educational best practices
 - i. Training in best practices pedagogy of online teaching
 - 1. Use in instructional technologies, instructional resources, multimedia hardware/software to support teaching and learning
 - ii. Training in best practices of online course design and development
 - 1. Structure, alignment, and tools/applications
 - 2. Compliance with copyright and licensing
 - b. Coordinates and directs online instructional design, development and delivery with quality control measures for online curriculum development and teaching
 - i. Establish and manage peer review teams for online curriculum development
 - ii. Establish and manage observation/evaluation process of online teaching
 - iii. Obtains student and community evaluations of online courses; manages feedback from students
- 2. Coordination of Online Program
 - a. Work with a team to establish a plan for online course/curriculum development
 - i. Identification of new online course/curriculum development
 - ii. Identification of faculty to develop or teach online courses/curriculum
 - iii. Meet/coordinate with online faculty/staff in meetings to plan and share best practices
- 3. Program Strategic Planning
 - a. Participate on Online Learning Advisory Committee
 - i. Coordinate work of architecture groups

- b. Read/research to stay current on online education trends, changes, developments and teaching strategies
- c. Participate in other areas of program planning
 - i. Student, school and community
 - ii. Technology
 - iii. Budget
- d. Participate in promotion/marketing efforts of courses/curriculum
 - i. Assist in data collection and analysis to assess the online learning program status and/or contribute to informed decisions
- e. Assist in preparation of reports summarizing program statistical data or describing online learning program objectives and accomplishments
 - i. Assist in evaluation of effectiveness of online learning program in meeting its goals in promoting knowledge and/or skill acquisition
 - ii. Assist in development/management of program budget

Work Environment

- Work primarily in a climate controlled environment with minimal safety/health hazard potential
- Requires the kind of teamwork, supervision and personal interaction that cannot be had in a home office situation; consequently, regular and predictable on-site attendance is a job requirement

- Master's degree in instructional design/technology or related field, or a combination of a bachelor's degree and certificate of program completion in instructional design/technology
- At least two years' work experience to include instructional design and/or online curriculum development
