TECHNOLOGY ASSOCIATE

OVERVIEW: Lexington Christian Academy is accepting applications for an immediate opening in our Technology Department for a skilled Technology Associate. This position will report to the Director of IT and Data Management and is responsible for providing level 1 and 2 technology support for LCA faculty, staff, students, and parents. This position requires general knowledge of networking, Microsoft server technologies like active directory and group policy, PCs (both windows and mac), iPads and Surface Pro tablets. This person should have a desire to grow in the IT field with a variety of hardware and software, excellent problem solving skills, and present a great service attitude to users.

We are looking for someone who wants to grow in the IT field. In addition to tech support, the IT team does a variety of projects (infrastructure upgrades and supporting BYOD) that this person can actively become involved in to learn a new aspect of IT. There is also the opportunity to be involved in teaching, being involved in school productions, and introducing new technologies (for example 3D printing) to teachers and students.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Network & Systems Administration

- Assists in maintaining all hardware in the LCA domain.
- Creates and maintains user accounts in windows active directory and google.
- Maintains surveillance and reports on network activity.
- Assists in infrastructure improvement projects for network, server, workstations, and tablets.
- Help document and keep current IT policy and procedures.

User Support

- Primary point of contact for first and second level end-user support
- Assists in the training of end-users for various technologies
- Responsible for support of software including Senior Systems, FinalSite portals, Google docs, & Microsoft office.
- Responsible for some end-user documentation, tech tips, how-to's, etc.
- Assists in prioritizing tech needs as they arise, according to higher vision

Academic Technology

- Assists in long range planning, device selection and purchasing, rollout, etc. of 1:1 program
- Provides first level support for all end-user 1:1 issues
- First point of contact for all repairs and support calls with vendors

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of a variety of hardware and software platforms
- Good troubleshooting capabilities
- Good installation and configuration abilities
- Knowledge of Windows 7, 8.1, (interest in 10), Mac OSX 10.7, iOS 7, 8
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office
- Excellent people skills and customer service attitude
- Ability to perform repairs and upgrades on a variety of computers, and peripherals, operating on Mac and Windows platforms, as well as iOS devices
- Knowledge of Active Directory, Group Policy, and Open Directory
- Excellent analytical and problem solving skills; clear written and oral communication skills; focus on results and outcomes
- Must be self-motivated and have the ability to work individually
- Ability to lift 40 pounds
