

Technology Educator - Part Time

Summary:

A CVCA technology teacher is called to educate and cultivate servants for Christ within his or her classroom and other interactions with the CVCA student body. This part-time educator will be responsible for teaching up to four sections of technology classes each semester, revising and developing the technology curriculum at CVCA in collaboration with other faculty and administration, and performing any other non-teaching duties as assigned.

Position Requirements:

- Full support for CVCA's mission, vision, and core values
- Passion to teach technology in a Christian environment with the mission to educate and cultivate servants for Christ
- A clear desire and ability to teach in a student centered learning environment
- Interest in innovatively bringing appropriate technology into the classroom to support student learning
- Strong communication skills
- Bachelor's degree in computer/technology education, educational technology, or a field related to technology
- ACSI certification or ability to obtain ACSI certification prior to employment

Ideal Qualifications:

- Graduate degree in education, educational technology or a field related to technology.
- State of Ohio teaching certificate, grades 7-12
- Five years experience teaching in grades 7-12 at various levels
- Comprehensive content mastery ranging from middle school through AP Computer Science
- Demonstrated experience in innovatively and appropriately bringing technology into the classroom to amplify and accelerate student learning
- Ability and interest in involvement in the CVCA co-curricular program (related experience preferred).

Note: While the initial teaching assignment for this part-time position will be primarily keyboarding and computer applications literacy, the position has the potential to adjust (including the possibility of full-time status) in the future toward offering more advanced coursework.
