ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY

In September, 2018, Montcrest is excited to open a K-8 Makerspace. A maker and STEAM approach to teaching and learning is currently embedded in our classrooms and this space will further support maker and STEAM initiatives. We are seeking a Makerspace, Technology, and Innovation Coordinator to begin with us in August, 2018. The successful candidate will oversee our Makerspace and support student learning, understanding, and engagement through maker and STEAM activities. This position reports to the Assistant Head, Teaching and Learning and works collaboratively with the faculty.

Responsibilities:

- Facilitate hands-on projects with students that nurture individual student learning interests
- Work collaboratively with teachers, to plan, develop, and implement a maker approach to

learning within the curriculum to support innovative education and to deepen student understanding

- Team-teach with teachers
- Create opportunities and programming in the Makerspace
- Develop student technology skills such as TinkerCad, GoogleSuite Apps, Scratch, and Minecraft
- Lead related student clubs and other co-curricular programming
- Plan and lead professional development programming and workshops for faculty
- · Create safe operating procedures for tools and equipment
- Manage the Makerspace scheduling, inventory, and equipment upkeep

The ideal candidate:

- Passionate about learning, the maker movement, and STEAM
- Experience with inquiry-based learning and curriculum integration with a student-centered approach
- · Identifies as a teacher, learner, designer, inventor, scientist, and/or researcher
- Experience with coding, using media, design, and digital fabrication tools
- Able to engage in a wide variety of maker activities such as, soldering, 3D printing, and sewing
- Growth mindset
- A willingness to take risks and a desire to look beyond traditional disciplines
- Inspire students and teachers by fostering curiosity, creativity, and innovation in learning
- · Strong interpersonal skills to establish connections with students, colleagues, and parents
- Strong collaborative skills and demonstrated ability to work as part of a team
- · A self-starter who is able to initiate and work in a self-directed manner
- Excellent communication skills including the ability to be an active listener
- Excellent time management and organizational skills
- · Enthusiasm for exploring new trends and tools for learning
- A commitment toward continued professional development and growth
- Energy, commitment, and a readiness to participate in the diverse life of the school community
